No late applications will be considered. Successful applicants will be notified by the end of Term 1 2025.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Participation in the MP Choral Festival 2024.
- The expectation that successful choirs participate in the MPCF in 2025, so that the Grants can be publicly acknowledged.
- Previous recipients are welcome to apply.
- * The grant must be spent by October 2025, at which time we also request a brief description of how and when the money was spent.
